

- **SUM:** Adds a range of cells.
- **AVERAGE:** Calculates the average value of a range of cells.
- **COUNT:** Counts the number of cells in a range that contain data.
- **MAX:** Returns the maximum value in a range of cells.
- **MIN:** Returns the minimum value in a range of cells.

Logical Functions






